## Camp-Goers Are Asked to Donate Easter Baskets for Underserved Children

The students will also watch a brief performance by current company dancers with the Ballet On Wheels Theatre of Dance.

"This camp makes us feel good knowing we are sharing our talents with the students, and in turn, they are passing that spirit of giving on to someone else," said Conner. "Through our non-profit organization, we take advantage of every opportunity possible to be a positive force in our community."
